The Madison Square Garden Company Announces Jerry Seinfeld Residency to Continue Through 2017 at the Historic Beacon Theatre

"Jerry Seinfeld: The Homestand" Will Continue With 12 Shows in First Half of 2017

NEW YORK, Nov. 10, 2016 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- Due to popular demand following his successful 2016 sold-out run, The Madison Square Garden Company (NYSE:MSG) announced today that legendary New Yorker and comedian Jerry Seinfeld has added 12 performances between January and June 2017 to his Beacon Theatre residency entitled, "Jerry Seinfeld: The Homestand." The 2017 dates are as follows: Thursday, January 5; Thursday, February 9; Thursday, March 16; Thursday, April 13; Thursday, May 18 and Thursday, June 8, with performances at 7:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. on all six nights. Tickets for all 12 shows will go on-sale on Wednesday, November 16 at 10:00 a.m.

"I had a feeling this was going to happen. I have enjoyed doing shows at The Beacon so much it has become a bit of an obsession and I can't stop," said Jerry Seinfeld.

"We are so thrilled to welcome Jerry back for the second year of his wildly successful residency at the Beacon Theatre. His distinctive style of comedy and sense of humor continues to delight and entertain us all," said Doc O'Connor, president and chief executive officer, The Madison Square Garden Company. "Like The Beacon, Jerry is a true icon of the city and 'Jerry Seinfeld: The Homestand' is a uniquely New York event that can only be seen at one of the most historic and special venues in NYC."

Entertainment icon Jerry Seinfeld's comedy career took off after his first appearance on The Tonight Show with Johnny Carson in 1981. Eight years later, he teamed up with fellow comedian Larry David to create what was to become the most successful comedy series in the history of television: Seinfeld. The show ran on NBC for nine seasons, winning numerous Emmy, Golden Globe and People's Choice awards, and was named the greatest television show of all time in 2009 by TV Guide, and in 2012 was identified as the best sitcom ever in a 60 Minutes/Vanity Fair poll.

Seinfeld has also starred in, written and produced movies (Comedian, Bee Movie), directed and produced a Broadway hit (Colin Quinn Long Story Short), and even wrote a best-selling book (Seinlanguage) and a children's book (Halloween).

Seinfeld directed the off-Broadway production of Colin Quinn: The New York Story and the upcoming Netflix stand-up special.

Seinfeld's latest project is critically-acclaimed web series Comedians in Cars Getting Coffee, seen exclusively on Crackle and comediansincarsgettingcoffee.com, which has garnered over 100 million views, and which the New York Times describes as "impressively complex and artful" and Variety calls "a game changer."

Seinfeld resides in New York City with his wife and three children. He remains active as a standup comedy performer, continuously touring both nationally and internationally.

Acquired by The Madison Square Garden Company in 2006, the Beacon Theatre is one of New York's most revered theaters and is a beloved New York landmark. In 2008, the 2,800-seat venue located on the Upper West Side underwent a seven-month restoration period focused on bringing the venue back to its original 1929 grandeur. For the past two decades the Beacon Theatre has operated as a successful concert and special events venue, hosting some of the biggest names and events in entertainment. The Beacon Theatre is part of a portfolio of world-class venues under The Madison Square Garden Company including Madison Square Garden, The Theater at Madison Square Garden and Radio City Music Hall; the Forum in Inglewood, California; The Chicago Theatre; and the Wang Theatre in Boston, MA.

Ticket prices for the 2017 Beacon run are: \$195.00, \$99.50 and \$85.00. These prices include the \$6.00 facility fee. All other fees will be added on top of these prices. Tickets for all 12 shows go on sale on Wednesday, November 16 at 10:00 a.m. and will be available online at beacontheatre.com and ticketmaster.com and Ticketmaster Charge By Phone at 866-858-0008. Tickets will be available at the Beacon Theatre box office starting on Thursday, November 17.
