Analogic to Premiere Revolutionary Airport Checkpoint CT Scanner, ConneCT, in the Asia-Pacific Region

System to Make Its Debut at Australian Airports Association's National Conference in Adelaide, Australia November 13-17

ConneCT is the only second-generation computed tomography (CT) system available for passenger checkpoints and has already been shown in Europe, the Middle East and the Americas to receptive airport and government audiences.

Analogic's ConneCT has achieved U.S. Transportation Security Administration (TSA) certification and has met the European Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC) C2 standard for Explosive Detection Systems. It was recently approved by the Australian Office of Transport Security and added to the Aviation Security Screening Equipment List.

Analogic will have the system available for demonstration with sales partner SX Technologies at the Australian Airports Association's National Conference in Adelaide, Booth 32-35, November 13—17.

"Recently foiled terror plots in the region have highlighted the need for highly advanced security solutions that bring a new standard of threat detection to the market," said Mark Laustra, vice president of Global Business Development and Government Relations. "The engineering team at Analogic has developed a transformative CT system for airport checkpoints that will keep the traveling public safer than ever before."
