



## **Analogic Corporation Receives \$10 Million Order for Its Explosives Detection Systems**

The certified eXaminer(R) 3DX Explosives Detection System (EDS), developed in collaboration between Analogic and L-3, incorporates the EXACT subsystem. This new order is expected to start shipping in the second quarter of fiscal 2010.

Peter Cempellin, vice president and general manager of Analogic's Security Systems Division, said, "This new order is indicative of the enduring value the eXaminer 3DX has in the marketplace and the role it plays in helping to protect the air traveling public. Analogic and L-3 remain committed to providing the most advanced CT-based threat detection available. More than 900 eXaminer 3DX systems are installed in airports around the world screening checked baggage. The system features advanced, multi-slice CT imaging technology and provides full 3-D images of all the contents of a bag, enabling automatic detection of explosives. Analogic and L-3 also provide the government-certified eXaminer SX and eXaminer XLB systems, which use the same CT-based technology to address various throughput needs of smaller and very large airports.
