10.14.14 The FireEye Labs team has identified two new zero-day vulnerabilities as part of limited, targeted attacks against some major corporations. FireEye Labs have identified 16 total zero-day attacks in the last two years – uncovering 11 in 2013 and five in 2014 so far.
