- (3) Of the reported shares 577,218 shares are represented by RSUs.
- (4) An option to purchase 2,646,456 shares was granted on September 24, 2010 and was exercised in part prior to the date on which the Reporting Person became subject to section 16. One-fourth of the shares subject to the option vested on September 7, 2011 and one forty-eighth of the shares vest monthly thereafter.
