Charter of the Environmental, Health & Safety Committee of the Board of Directors

Composition: The Board of Directors (the “Board”) of Chemtura Corporation (the “Corporation”) annually elects, by majority vote of the directors then in office, and on the recommendation of the Compensation & Governance Committee, the members of the Environmental, Health and Safety Committee (the “Committee”). The Board shall designate one member to serve as chairman of the Committee. No member of the Committee shall be an employee of the Corporation.

Purpose: The Committee is appointed by the Board to assist the Board in (1) providing guidance to and oversight of management with respect to environmental, health, safety, security and related regulatory affairs, including the regulation of products (collectively, “EH&S”), (2) encouraging management to take and implement, and recommending that the Board approve, actions and policies that will (a) enable the Corporation to achieve its EH&S performance objectives, (b) contribute to an improved public image and relationships in the communities where the Corporation operates, and (c) enhance the Corporation’s ability to meet its overall corporate objectives, and (3) any other related matters deemed appropriate.

**Authority
and Resources**

The Committee may conduct or authorize studies and investigations into any matters within the scope of its responsibilities and may retain outside legal counsel or other advisors to assist in the conduct of any such study or investigation or for any other reason as determined by the Committee. The Corporation shall pay such third parties retained by the Committee such compensation, including without limitation, usual and customary expenses and charges, as shall be determined by the Committee.

**Duties and
Responsibilities:**

The functions and authority of the Committee include:

Environmental Policies

- Reviewing the Corporation's objectives, targets and performance related to EH&S
- Reviewing the Corporation's practices and management systems related to EH&S
- Reviewing the Corporation's comprehensive emergency response strategy relating to EH&S
- Reviewing the Corporation's staff structure related to EH&S

External Relations

- Discussing the Corporation's approach to community relations with management and the Board
- Discussing with management and the Board the Corporation's approach to customer interactions related to EH&S

Governmental Relations

- Reviewing anticipated legislation, regulations, judicial decisions, treaties, protocols, conventions or other agreements, public policies or medical or other scientific developments involving the Corporation's EH&S affairs that may have an effect on the Corporation's business
- Reviewing government, political and economic matters related to the Corporation's EH&S affairs

Environmental Liability

- Reviewing the Corporation's response to EH&S-related litigation brought against the Corporation
- In conjunction with the Audit Committee, reviewing the appropriateness and sufficiency of accruals for contingent liabilities related to EH&S
- Reviewing compliance with laws and the Corporation's policies, standards and procedures related to EH&S
- Analyzing the cost-effectiveness of remedial activities

Self-Evaluation and Charter Review

- Annually reviewing this charter and recommending to the Board, where appropriate, modifications or additions hereto
- Performing an annual evaluation of the performance of the Committee in fulfilling the functions set forth in this charter

Other Duties and Responsibilities

- Obtaining, as appropriate, the services of internal or external legal or other advisors
- Performing any other duties or responsibilities delegated to the Committee by the Board
- Regularly reporting to the Board on the activities of the Committee

Meetings: The Committee shall meet at least two times each year, or more frequently as appropriate.
