


ANNUAL DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE
CALIFORNIA COMPREHENSIVE COMPLIANCE PROGRAM

In accordance with the “Compliance Program Guidance for Pharmaceutical Manufacturers” published by the Office of the Inspector General of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services in April 2003, the PhrMA Code on Interactions with Healthcare Professionals, and the State of California Health and Safety Codes §§ 119400–119402, Amphastar Pharmaceuticals, Inc., and its subsidiaries, International Medication Systems, Limited, and Armstrong Pharmaceuticals, Inc., (collectively “Company”) has established a Comprehensive Compliance Program (“CCP”) and hereby declares, to the best of its knowledge, and based on its good faith understanding of the statutory requirements, that it is in compliance with its CCP and the statutory requirements.
