On May 10, 2017, Brightcove Inc. (the "Company") held its annual meeting of stockholders (the "Annual Meeting") to consider and vote on the two proposals set forth below, each of which is described in greater detail in the Company's definitive proxy statement filed with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission on April 7, 2017. The final voting results are set forth below.

Proposal 1 - Election of Directors

The stockholders elected each of the two persons named below to serve as a Class II director of the Company for a three-year term that expires at the Company's annual meeting of stockholders in 2020 and until his or her successor has been duly elected and qualified, subject to his or her earlier resignation or removal.
