Marine Corps Awards ManTech \$21 Million for Systems Engineering Interoperability, Architecture, and Technology Support

ManTech ensures certified material solutions for Marine Corp Systems Command

HERNDON, Va., July 18, 2017 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- The Systems Engineering, Interoperability, Architecture and Technology (SIAT), U.S. Marine Corps (USMC) Systems Command has awarded ManTech International Corporation (Nasdaq:MANT) a 5-year \$21 million task order for systems engineering, interoperability, architecture, and technology support on the DoD Information Analysis Center's (DoD IAC) Defense Systems Technical Area Task (DSTAT) Multi-Award Contract (MAC).
