ManTech Wins \$80 Million Contract With U.S. Naval Air Systems Command Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division

5-Year Award by NAVAIR NAWCAD Extends ManTech's Role to Enhance and Plan Naval Air Warfare and Communications Capabilities

HERNDON, Va., July 25, 2017 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- ManTech International Incorporated (Nasdaq:MANT) today announced an \$80.3 million contract with the U.S. Naval Air Systems Command Naval Air Warfare Center Aircraft Division to support air warfare and related capability development activities of the Mission and Engineering and Analysis Department based in Patuxent River, Maryland.

Under the five-year agreement, ManTech will provide warfare analysis and assessments, acquisition analysis and support, modeling and simulation, weapon system technical publications and training, software development, data handling, and warfare analysis laboratory services. The work will support near- through far-term systems and capability development by spanning naval mission areas such as air, strike, and amphibious warfare; command, control, and communications; and cyber and electronic warfare.

"ManTech is proud to be a central partner with NAVAIR NAWCAD in advancing the warfighter capabilities of Navy and Marine aircraft personnel," said Daniel J. Keefe, president and chief operating officer of ManTech's Mission Solutions & Services Group. "This important award builds on our strategy of putting innovation and outstanding expertise to work where it counts most - in support of national security."

The new contract follows other recent ManTech/U.S. Navy/Marine Corps wins including a \$39 million contract with The Naval Surface Warfare Center Dahlgren Division (NSWCDD)/Combat Direction Systems Activity (CDSA) for [Fleet Support](#), a \$21 million task order with the Systems Engineering, Interoperability, Architecture and Technology (SIAT), U.S. Marine Corps (USMC) Systems Command, and a \$40 million NAWCAD award for reliability and maintenance (R & M), systems safety, diagnostics and testability services.
