## **PENNSYLVANIA AMERICAN WATER RELEASES WATER QUALITY REPORTS FOR McEWENSVILLE SERVICE AREA**

**HERSHEY, Pa. (May 19, 2017)** – Pennsylvania American Water announced today that the company’s 2016 Consumer Confidence Report have been posted online for the McEwensville service area. Reports can be accessed online under the Water Quality and Stewardship tab.

The annual report is a performance measure of the quality of water supplied by Pennsylvania American Water against the compliance standards established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. The report describes drinking water sources, testing conducted on the water, substances detected, and the levels of those substances. Commonly asked questions and the answers concerning drinking water are also included.

Pennsylvania American Water’s Consumer Confidence Reports, which are updated and posted annually, provide information to local customers. The report for the McEwensville service area water system includes Delaware Township.
