## PENNSYLVANIA AMERICAN WATER NAMES NEW COATESVILLE OPERATIONS SUPERINTENDENT

**COATESVILLE, Pa. (June 26, 2017)** – Pennsylvania American Water announced today the appointment of Justin Brame to the position of operations superintendent of its Coatesville area water and wastewater systems.

In his new role, Brame will oversee all aspects of the Coatesville operations, including distribution, collection, water treatment and wastewater treatment. Pennsylvania American Water provides water service to approximately 12,000 customers, as well as wastewater service to nearly 6,200 customers in western Chester County.
