## PENNSYLVANIA AMERICAN WATER PLANS \$920,000 PIPELINE UPGRADE IN CAMPBELLTOWN

**HERSHEY, Pa. (February 6, 2018)** – Pennsylvania American Water today announced the start of construction to replace aging water main along Route 322 in Campbelltown, South Londonderry Township to improve service reliability and prevent water outages. The project, with an estimated cost of nearly \$920,000, will replace outdated pipe dating back to the 1940s.

Starting this week, the company will install approximately 4,200 feet of new eight and 12-inch ductile iron pipe along Route 322 between Hinkle Road and west of Schoolhouse Road. Crews will work weekdays between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Traffic restrictions will in place during construction, and motorists are urged to give themselves extra time and exercise caution when traveling through the work zone.

The company expects to complete the new main installation, testing and disinfection, and connecting customers' service lines to the new main by the end of May, weather permitting. Final paving restoration will be performed by PENNDOT later this year.

During construction, customers might experience temporary water service interruptions, discolored water and/or lower than normal water pressure. For more information, contact Pennsylvania American Water's customer service center at 1-800-565-7292.
