New Jersey American Water Investing \$787,000 for Main Replacements in North Plainfield and Roselle

VOORHEES, N.J. (March 9, 2018) – New Jersey American Water is investing \$787,000 in new water mains in its service area of North Plainfield and Roselle. The approximate 3,900 feet of new ductile iron pipe replaces water main that was installed as far back as the 1930s.

In North Plainfield, New Jersey American Water's qualified contractor, Renda Construction, Inc. is currently working along:

- **Allen Place**, from Fairview Avenue to end of the roadway
- **Verdon Street**, from Summit Avenue to Grandview Avenue

Montana Construction, also a New Jersey American Water qualified contractor began work last week on the following streets:

In North Plainfield:

- **Lewis Street**, from Mountain Avenue to Corbett Place
- **Anworth Avenue**, from Farragut Road to Mali Drive
- **Jeffries Place**, from Mountain Avenue to Jeffries Place
- **Rutledge Court**, from Oneida Avenue to Rutledge Court

In Roselle:

- **East 1st Avenue**, from Drake Avenue to just past Sheridan Avenue
- **Drake Avenue**, from 2nd Avenue to 1st Avenue

All projects will be completed by the end of March with final street restoration being completed in the spring of 2018. Work hours will be from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, Mondays through Friday. Work outside of these hours is not expected unless required to maintain project schedule.

For the public's and workers' safety, traffic restrictions and/or alternating traffic patterns are likely to occur during work hours. All emergency vehicles and local traffic will be allowed access during construction.
