New Jersey American Water Investing \$1.2 Million in Mount Holly and Westampton

VOORHEES, N.J. (March 8, 2018) – [New Jersey American Water](#) is investing approximately \$1.2 million for the installation of new water mains in its Mount Holly and Westampton service areas. The approximate 5,100 feet of new pipe replaces water main that was installed as far back as the 1900s. The aging water lines will be replaced with ductile iron pipes.

New Jersey American Water's qualified contractor Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc. is currently working along **Brown Street**, from Rancocas Road to Grant Street. The project also includes replacing six fire hydrants and 110 utility-owned service lines along the pipeline route.

"This significant improvement project is part of the company's multimillion dollar program to accelerate the [renewal of water infrastructure](#) that is reaching the end of its useful life to help ensure continued reliable service," stated David Forcinito, senior director of Operations, South Region. "With the installation of the new water mains, customers should experience increased water flows for residences and fire protection, as well as continued improvement in reliability."

Work hours will be from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday through Friday. Work outside of these hours is not expected unless required to maintain the project schedule. Construction is expected to be completed by the end of March with final street restoration being completed in the summer of 2018.

For the public's and workers' safety, traffic restrictions and/or alternating traffic patterns are likely to occur during work hours. All emergency vehicles and local traffic will be allowed access during construction. New Jersey American Water values the safety of its workers and advises drivers and pedestrians to take caution in the vicinity of work sites.
