Again this year, the information in the reports confirms that Iowa American Water has met or surpassed all standards set by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), which are enforced by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.

Also known as the Consumer Confidence Report, this report compares the quality of water supplied by Iowa American Water against standards established by the EPA and Iowa Department of Natural Resources. The report describes local drinking water source information and shares test results, including all substances detected in the water and their levels.
