By 2025, Apache is committed to reducing its methane emissions to 0.36% or less of total methane production

- ▶ Since 2012, we have reduced our methane emissions intensity by 43 percent



The safety of our employees, contractors and communities is Apache's highest priority and is deeply rooted in our Core Values

- ▶ Over the past five years, we have reduced our Vehicle Incident Rate (VIR)² by 27 percent and our Workforce Total Recordable Incident Rate (TRIR)³ by 54 percent



We seek to use alternatives to potable fresh water—such as recycled produced water—in all of our operating regions, especially in areas of the U.S. and Egypt that could be considered “water scarce,” depending on conditions, location, pricing and regulations

- ▶ In 2016, 97 percent of our water withdrawals were from nonpotable sources
