



CONFLICT MINERALS STATEMENT

Avid Technology, Inc. and its subsidiaries (“Avid”) are committed to sourcing components and materials from companies that share our values regarding respect for human rights, integrity, and environmental responsibility.

Avid is committed to complying with the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas (“OECD Guidance”), as well as the requirements of Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, which aims to prevent the use of tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold (“conflict minerals”) that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (“DRC”) or in adjoining countries.

Avid intends to require its suppliers to, in accordance with the OECD Guidance, source and track the chain of custody of all conflict minerals contained in any products or materials provided by the suppliers to Avid.

Avid is committed to working towards becoming “conflict-free” (which means that such supplier does not source conflict minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the DRC or adjoining countries).
