Bâtard Montrachet 1996 Domaine Leflaive sold for a mouth-watering £16,940 against an estimate of £4,200-5,500 and other Grands Crus from this ever-popular producer also soared over their high estimates. Red Burgundy from Domaine de la Romanée Conti and

Armand Rousseau were flying high, whilst fine collections of other top Burgundy producers, Bordeaux and Champagne were equally in strong demand, taking the overall total to a figure well over the high estimate. We now look forward to a sequence of excellent sales in London, New York and Hong Kong this September.”
