## **CACI Awarded Prime Position on \$300 Million Multiple-Award Contract to Develop Cyber Technologies in Support of the Air Force Research Laboratory**

### ***New Work Will Help U.S. Forces Stay Ahead of the Increasing Cyber Threat***

With an anticipated ceiling value of \$300 million, this five-year indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contract represents new work for CACI and further expands the company's cyberspace solutions capability.
