Shameek Konar was named Senior Vice President, Corporate Strategy and Development of Constellation Energy in 2009. In this role, he is responsible for realigning the company's business model to deliver stable, long-term growth, while continuing to de-risk our business. In addition, he has primary responsibility for assessing strategic and tactical opportunities for capital investment, continuing to support Constellation Energy's longer term objectives.

Mr. Konar most recently served as managing director, corporate strategy and development for the company's merchant business arm, Constellation Energy Resources. In this capacity, he led the divestitures of the company's international coal and freight and downstream gas businesses as part of Constellation Energy's effort to improve its liquidity position and restructure its business mix. Having joined Constellation Energy in June 2003, Mr. Konar also served as a managing director in the commodities business, where he directed the company's gas asset portfolio and was involved in the acquisition of a number of properties during his tenure.

Prior to joining Constellation Energy, he was a consultant in Accenture's Strategy and Business Architecture group, where he worked on advising merchant energy companies on trading and risk management-related issues. Mr. Konar started his career at Putnam, Hayes and Bartlett (subsequently acquired by Hagler Bailly) as an economic consultant in the energy industry, focusing on policy issues around competitive energy markets, asset valuation and financing, as well as preparing companies to function in restructured energy markets.

Mr. Konar earned a doctorate in economics and finance from Vanderbilt University and an undergraduate degree in economics from St. Stephen's College in New Delhi, India.
