Baltimore Gas and Electric Company Encourages Qualifying Customers To Attend Energy Assistance Expo in Baltimore City

*Customers urged to seek assistance prior to the start of extremely cold weather
and not wait until they are in crisis*

BALTIMORE, Nov. 6, 2009 – Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (BGE), a subsidiary of Constellation Energy (NYSE: CEG), today announced it is hosting an *Energy Assistance Expo* to help customers who may qualify for energy assistance. The *Expo* takes place Saturday, Nov. 7, from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. at Baltimore City Community College, 2901 Liberty Heights Ave., Baltimore, MD. The Office of Home Energy Programs (OHEP) and the Office of State Senator Catherine Pugh are partnering with BGE on this event.

“Once again BGE is reaching out to its limited income customers and strongly encouraging them to apply for energy assistance before the start of winter and before they find themselves in crisis. By securing energy assistance early, customers may be able to avoid an interruption in service, which is always a last resort for BGE,” said Jeannette M. Mills, senior vice president of customer relations and account services for BGE. “During the Expo, BGE employees will not only assist customers with the application process, they will also provide customers with important information on how to make their homes more energy efficient and reduce energy usage. Information on the many offerings of BGE’s *Smart Energy Savers Programs*SM will also be available.”

Customers who have not qualified for energy assistance in the past are encouraged to attend the *Expo* as income guidelines have changed. New income eligibility guidelines for the current enrollment period are as follows:

Household Size	Maximum Monthly Gross Income
1	\$1,579.37
2	\$2,124.79
3	\$2,670.20
4	\$3,215.62
5	\$3,761.04
6	\$4,306.45

For each additional person in the household, add \$545.42.

Eligible applicants must have an existing BGE account or be in the process of applying for a new account. Customers applying for energy assistance should bring the following with them for fast and efficient processing:

- Government issued photo identification
- Proof of total gross income for the last 30 days for all household members
- Proof of residence (lease, rent book, mortgage statement, etc.)
- Copies of Social Security cards for all household members including children
- Copy of most recent utility bill
- Name of home energy supplier and account number

BGE estimates 200,000 customers in its service area are limited income; however, only approximately 50,000 of those customers apply for OHEP assistance. Additionally, customers who need aid beyond the OHEP grant may contact the Fuel Fund of Maryland, BGE Community Assistance Fund, as well as other community based organizations. While energy assistance events are held periodically throughout the year, qualifying customers can apply for grants at any OHEP office during normal business hours.
