



Ecolab And FQCC Co-Organize Second Annual China Meat Products Safety and Trade Development Forum

SHANGHAI, China, September 26, 2008 - Ecolab China announced today that it has jointly organized the second annual "China Meat Products Safety and Trade Development Forum" with the Food Quality and Safety Certification Center (FQCC), an independent legal entity of China's Ministry of Commerce. The Forum will take place in Beijing on Sept. 26-27, 2008.
