Thousands of dollars in prize money is available for original forensic artifacts

The program was created as a forum for digital forensic security researchers to share information and be recognized for the critical work they do to investigate cybercrime and stop cyber threats.

"Digital forensic researchers work on a daily basis to uncover evidence and new methodologies to help defend against crime and cyberattacks," said Michael Harris, chief marketing officer at Guidance.
