



Lars Moller Named President of DMI Industries

Lars Moller has been named president of DMI Industries, a wind tower manufacturer based in West Fargo. DMI is an operating company of Otter Tail Corporation (NASDAQ:OTTR).

Moller succeeds Mike Hohl, who stepped down at the end of September. "Mike was instrumental in changing the DMI business focus from a sugar beet equipment company to what it is today, a leading manufacturer of wind towers," said Chuck Hoge, Otter Tail vice president.
