14 Describe the organizational action and, if applicable, the date of the action or the date against which shareholders' ownership is measured for the action ▶ On August 15, 2017, PC-TEL, Inc. paid a quarterly dividend of \$0.055 per share to shareholders of record as of August 8, 20

15 Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ Dividends paid in excess of the current and accumulated earnings and profits of a corporation reduce the basis of the shares of the corporation pursuant to Internal Revenue Code ("IRC") 301 (c) (2) and 316 (a).

PC-TEL made a cash distribution of \$0.055 on August 15, 2017 for holders of each share of common stock. At this time, based on reasonable assumptions by PC-TEL, Inc., this distribution is expected to be a non-taxable return of capital thereby reducing a shareholders basis by \$0.05 per share.

16 Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶ Based upon reasonable assumptions by PC-TEL, Inc., the full amount of the distribution paid to shareholders on August 15, 2017 should reduce the basis of each share of Common Stock held by each shareholder on date of payment as PC-TEL is not expected to have any earnings and profits (current or accumulated) as of December 31, 2017. Pursuant to applicable Treasury regulations under Section 6045B, if these assumptions turn out to be incorrect, PC-TEL, Inc. will file a corrected Form 8937 within 45 days of such determination.
