Ronnie Dunn concert from The Stage in Nashville to air on SiriusXM's Prime Country on May 25

"SiriusXM's Town Hall with Ronnie Dunn" will air live on Prime Country, channel 58, on Thursday, May 24 at 12:00 pm ET. The special will be hosted by SiriusXM host Storme Warren.
