

**SONIC CORP.
CODE OF ETHICS
FOR FINANCIAL OFFICERS**

This Code provides principles to which the Chief Executive Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Chief Accounting Officer and Treasurer are expected to adhere and advocate. This Code embodies rules regarding individual and peer responsibilities, as well as responsibilities to other employees, the public and other stakeholders. The named financial officers are expected to abide by this Code as well as any other applicable Sonic policies or guidelines. Any violations of this Code may result in disciplinary action, up to and including immediate termination.

The Chief Executive Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Chief Accounting Officer and Treasurer will:

1. Act with honesty and integrity, avoiding actual or apparent conflicts of interest in personal and professional relationships.
2. Provide stockholders with information that is complete, accurate, timely, and understandable in reports and documents that Sonic submits to the SEC and in other public communications made by Sonic.
3. Comply with applicable governmental laws, rules and regulations.
4. Respect the confidentiality of information acquired in the course of one's work except when authorized or otherwise legally obligated to disclose.
5. Not use confidential information acquired in the course of one's work for personal advantage.
6. Promptly report violations of this Code to the Chair of the Audit Committee and to the Vice President of Internal Audit by using any one of the following methods:
